### COLUMBUS CLUB HENRY MOORE, PRESIDENT

I want to congratulate all the new officers for the 2010-2011 fraternal year. President is Henry Moore, vice president will be Gary Barker, Sammy Ray and Marvin Copenhaver are still on the board, and the directors for the year are Waylon Horn, Dickie Spahn, and Robert Collins.

At the last meeting, I presented a quote for a new ice machine and a new compressor for the cooler at the Acres. The compressor is completely gone, and the ice machine is really struggling to keep going. We received a quote from Markham Restaurant Supply for the two machines:

New compressor and labor for the cooler at the acres	\$2880.00
New ice machine and bin	\$3200.00
Less trade in on old ice machine	(\$525.00)
Less for discount (donation)	(\$1675.00)
Total with tax	\$4238.90

The Council received commitments from three members for a total of \$2500.00 toward this project, leaving a balance right at \$1800.00. A motion was made, and second, to wait until after the truck show at the end of July to try and get the remaining \$1800.00 from Council funds (Details of the truck show in another article).

Some of the members present thought we only used the cooler at the Acres once or twice a year. Fact is, we use the cooler a lot more, than originally thought, throughout the year. Also, the cooler may not look like very good but it is well built as it will maintain temperature in the hot summer months. If we receive the remaining \$1800.00 from donations from members, we may proceed with the project before August since Council funds will not be involved.

Also, I have one final note. If Sammy Ray's figures are correct, when we make our loan payment at the first of July, the balance after the payment on the loan will be right at \$3000.00. It is hard for me to be completely accurate as the information on the loan always comes in after the deadline for the bulletin.

## SLAMILY CAR AND TRUCK SHOW HENRY MOORE

There will be a large car and truck show at Columbus Acres on Saturday, July 31st, and Sunday, August 1st. We have been asked to handle the food and drink concessions for this event. This truck show was here last year, and the Council handled all the drinks and 1/2 of the food concessions. This year, we have it all. We have the potential of making (clear) around \$3800.00. We will need help with the drinks, beer, and food outside on the midway, and we will also need help in the lounge, as we will also be selling food and drinks in there (different menu in the lounge). The hours on Saturday, July 31st, will be as follows: 7:00 am—9:30 am—Simple breakfast in the lounge. 10:30 am—4:00 pm, food on the midway and food in the hall. Drinks will be served on the midway until 5:00 pm, when the show is over for Saturday. Sunday, August 1st, the food and drink hours on the midway and in the lounge will run from 10:30 am to 2:00 pm.

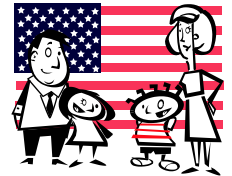
